1. Minutes of Previous Meeting

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and signed as correct.

2. The Horse Dock

The Chairman reported to the meeting that he had been to see Dr Moseley and that he (Dr Moseley) would be writing a letter to the Parish Council. It was decided that nothing else should be done until the Council receives the letter.

3. Proposed Road

Councillor G. Woollard read out a letter from Mr Oldridge of the County of Cambridge. This stated that there is no money at present for the road on the top Green to be done but the Council will patch up the existing carriageway.

4. Burial Charges

The revised burial charges have been received from Swaffham Bulbeck Parish Council. It was resolved that the burial charges for Reach should be: burial £15, exclusive right £20, child not exceeding 12 years £7.50. Headstone £10 and a vase £5.

5. Reach Fair

Mr Harris's deposit of £10 is to be returned to him.

6. Planning Applications

The Planning Application submitted by Mr Piggott for erection of a house and garage adjacent to White Roses, Great Lane. The Parish Council have no comments to make.

The application by Eastern Electricity for O/H line diversion, Great Lane - no comments.

Mr Cannon's application for alterations and extensions with new garage, 23 Great Lane. The Council expressed concern concerning the proposed access. No mention of turning space on the plans therefore presume vehicles will have to back out onto the road and at this point there is a blind corner. No objections to the alterations.

7. Cheques
